



Gothic church founded in honour of Our Lady by Alfonso III the Liberal, after the conquest of Menorca in 1287. It was built during the whole of the XIV century in the same place where there had once been a Muslim mosque. The church has only one nave which leads to a polygonal apse. On either side we find different chapels, bearing testimony to various historical events and artistic styles. One of the most notable styles is manifested in "La capilla de las Animas", Chapel of the Souls, built in 1670 and which is one of the most interesting examples of Baroque art to be found on the island.
