



Built on a high level at the entrance of the port of Ciutadella, it was built at the end of the XVII century with the object of defending the town from sea attacks. It is a tower in the shape of a truncated pyramid with an octagonal floor built with blocks of marés (a special type of sandy stone used in Minorca). Inside an octagonal central column supports the artillery platform on which there is a small tower and from where it was much easier to keep a look out over the port. The exterior which is on a slope is surrounded by a pit of eight metres wide and two deep with a bridge in front of the door
