



A group of sandstone quarries that have been restored by the Líthica Association.

The s'Hostal enclosure forms a monumental sculpted landscape of incredible beauty, the result of man's work.

An ethnological heritage of Minorca, the sandstone quarries are also authentic landscape sculptures that, in s'Hostal, are present in two very different morphological zones.

On one side there are the more modern quarries, a result of mechanical extraction of the stone. These are made up of two monumental cubic empty spaces with straight walls, marked by saws. Today, the quarries are used for cultural and leisure activities.

On the other side, in the old quarries, the spaces are irregular, with walls engraved by old tools and coloured by a diversity of colour tones that erosion over time has given. Today a mix of spontaneous vegetation and remains of old orchards populate the spaces between walls, accompanied by the new garden created by the Líthica association, such as the medieval garden and the botanical circuit of indigenous plants.
