



General museum which illustrates the history of mankind in Menorca through his furniture and possessions. Worth noting are the rooms dedicated to the pre-historical era, the early history of Minorca and Minorca in the XVIII century. There is also a room devoted to traditional, Minorcan, artisan trades and a magnificent collection of paintings and engravings from the XVIII and XIX centuries.

The rooms were once the living quarters of the Franciscan monks who occupied this beautiful cloister in the XVIII century.
