



The Cap de Cavalleria Ecomuseum receives visitors from the Cavalleria area and from the Sanitja harbour. In the Saint Teresa house there is an exhibition hall where the public is informed about the natural and cultural heritage of the northernmost territory of the island of Minorca.

Visitors to the ecomuseum receive synthetic and general information on this territory by means of various audiovisual systems, models, scenes and exhibits of archaeological material reproduced from the archaeological digs carried out in the harbour of Sanitja. The exhibition has translations in six languages: English, Spanish, Catalan, German, French and Italian.

The new "Discover the north!" exhibition, inaugurated at the end of July 2005, gives a general view of the elements of the landscape, both natural and cultural: lighthouse, English tower, Roman city, Roman military camp, Muslim mosque, etc. These are just some of the attractions.

The exhibition continues, pointing out the most important points of the territory in terms of natural and cultural values, in order that the visitor can continue with the free visit to the exterior zone, starting the itinerary by means of the "7 routes" guide, using as a reference point the viewpoint located a few metres away from the exit of the museum.
