



Prehistoric town which remained until the end of the Roman period of which the taula and a talayot are conserved along with some man-made caves excavated in the rocky subsoil. Some burial chambers excavated in the rock, probably from the high Middle Ages are also conserved. The taula is one of the most beautiful of the island, with a reinforced column at the back part but it has not conserved the enclosure which it would have had at the time.
