



Torrellafuda is a prehistoric settlement with a great landscape beauty due to its setting – a holm-oak grove – that gives it a relaxing atmosphere. Visitors discover the remains of this settlement as they walk through it.

The remains are conserved of various talayots, some burial caves from the end of the talayotic period, a taula and various remains of dwellings with rooms attached. The settlement was walled and a few stretches of wall of considerable height are conserved. It was inhabited until the end of Roman times. The taula stands out, with a natural covering of vegetation.
